

## Oklahoma Singer Records "Heart of Adoption" Album

**Music Aims to Find Homes for Foster Kids: November is 'National Adoption Month'**

**Oct. 17th, 2011, Tahlequah, OK:** Becky Wright, mom of nine and former school music teacher, is on a mission "to find homes for kids", particularly kids in US foster care. Wright has just completed recording her fourth full-length album, entitled "The Heart of Adoption", which is slated to officially release Oct. 25th. Giving voice to the fatherless, the orphan, the foster child, and the forgotten, these ten songs are an eclectic mix of inspirational, rock, R & B (with 12-year-old EJ Avery performing "Who's My Daddy"), country (brand new recording of "Child of My Heart" with Tommy Brandt), and the heart-gripping ballad of a birth mother who relinquishes her baby, "I Gave You Away". Songs of faith, family, hope, and divine intervention, including "Entertaining Angels, Unaware" are certain to inspire. Working closely with Oklahoma's [www.111project.org](http://www.111project.org) and other organizations nationwide, Wright hopes to raise public awareness and enlist more foster and adoptive families through the music.

Producer, Robert Jason (Reba McEntire, Oak Ridge Boys, Alabama, Disney) says: *"I have found no album or artist more worthy of my efforts than Becky Wright and the 'Heart of Adoption' project. It truly is 'music that matters', and I pray it makes a huge impact for thousands of children to find the love of a family."*

Two singles were simultaneously released to approximately 1700 Christian radio stations on Oct. 4th by Christian Radio Weekly/ Westar Media, Inc. "The Forgotten", co-written by Becky and Sean C. Smith, is a driving and passionate rock rendition of the biblical reminder to "remember... the least of these". The famed Bonnie Keen (of the CCM group First Call) joins Becky on the hopeful Wynonna-styled "What Love Will Do", which will also release to selected country stations.

Dave Koch, President of Westar Media Inc., said, *"Becky Wright must have won 'Female Songwriter of the Year' at the 2011 Agape Fest for good reason. Her talent and passion are reaching out for the sake of orphans, foster parenting and adoption, evidenced in two powerful songs titled "The Forgotten" and "What Love Will Do." Becky's music and message will resonate with fans of similar artists such as Steven Curtis Chapman, Natalie Grant, Casting Crowns, Avalon and country music icon, Martina McBride. This November, I encourage radio stations all across the U.S. to feature these two songs during 'National Adoption Month'."*

"The Heart of Adoption" CD will be available online Oct. 28th. Downloads are available now at [www.beckywrightsongs.com](http://www.beckywrightsongs.com), and will be added to I-tunes, AmazonMp3, Rhapsody, and several others in the coming weeks. Discussions are also underway for possible distribution through LifeWay Christian Stores.
